Ouabache Trails Park Campground General Rules and Regulations

- □ Quiet Hours: 10:00 p.m. to 9:00 a.m.
- □ Pets must be on leash in all areas. Please do not leash pets to trees or shrubs. You are responsible for your pets. If you can not control them or if their barking becomes a disturbance, you will be notified of the problem. If it is not taken care of, you will be asked to leave.
- □ Loud music will not be tolerated.
- □ Firearms are prohibited in all park areas.
- □ Fireworks are prohibited in all park areas.
- □ Campfires are permitted in fire rings only.
- □ All motorized vehicles are required to observe the park speed limit and are restricted to roadways and designated parking areas only. Parking on grass is prohibited without authorization.
- □ Golf Carts:
 - o Campers must show proof of insurance (you will be able to use your golf cart without insurance for your first visit). A copy will be kept on file.
 - o Three persons per seat
 - o Children must be accompanied by an adult.
- □ Gathering of loose or dead wood in forested areas is prohibited.
- □ A maximum of two vehicles and one tent is permitted with R.V. site rental.
- □ RV site stays are unlimited, providing there is not a conflicting reservation. All tent sites are limited to a ten-day stay. Tents using RV sites are limited to a ten-day stay. Reservations are accepted year round (deposit required).
- □ Please stay out of landscaping.
- □ Alcohol is restricted to registered guests only and must be kept on your site. Please be responsible. All state laws apply.
- Campground shelter house is open for registered campers unless reservation is posted.
- □ Laundry center hours: 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
- □ For questions, assistance or to report rules or law violations, please see your campground host or co-host (site #4 or 32) or call the parks office at (812) 882-4316.
- Please do not feed wild animals. Feeding of wild animals can result in harm to both animals and people. Animals that depend on handouts become a nuisance to park visitors and a danger to themselves. Please lock or store all food and coolers inside cars, tents or campers.

Please be respectful and courteous to other campers to ensure that everyone can experience the pleasures of camping.

Our campground host and co-host have the authority to enforce all park rules and regulations. If you can not follow the park rules or regulations, you will be asked to leave.

Observance of our parks rules and regulations, which are designed for the safety and enjoyment of all people and the environment means a quality experience for everyone.
